**WOOD COUNTY ORDINANCE #104  
ENHANCED 911 TELEPHONE SYSTEM**

**Chapter 104 .01 PURPOSE**

An Ordinance establishing and authorizing a user charge to finance the Wood County Enhanced 911 Telephone System.

**Chapter 104 .02 ORDINANCE**

**E-911 System**

Wood County has developed and will operate an enhanced 911 emergency telephone number system. That system will be maintained and operated in accordance with the "Plan" maintained by the Emergency Government, the telephone utilities involved in its operation and the Public Service Commission, all pursuant to the provisions in SS 146.70, Wis. Stats. Said plan and contract, as periodically modified, are adopted and incorporated herein by reference thereto.

**Cost Assessment**

All telephone users in Wood County shall have access to an E-911 emergency telephone system and shall be required to pay the costs of said system as authorized by Wisconsin Statutes 146.70(3), and as determined by contract between Wood County and the telephone utility companies serving such users and as approved by the Public Service Commission.

**Cost Levy and Collection**

All telephone utility companies serving Wood County shall bill their Wood County service users for the costs referred to herein and in 146.70 Wis. Stats., as approved by the Public Service Commission. The actual service user fee shall be set forth by contract with the telephone utilities. All revenues collected from the user service charge must be applied to the actual, authorized costs incurred in the installation and maintenance of the E-911 emergency telephone number system.

**Chapter 104 .03 EFFECTIVE**

This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication.

Section 2.

That at said time the E-911 system becomes operational, which is anticipated to be in the summer of 1996, that Wood County Ordinance 103, Basic 911 Telephone System, shall be rescinded.
