Wisconsin law allows for parents to relinquish rights to infants less than 3 days old with an employee of a hospital, fire station, sheriff's office, police station, emergency medical services provider, or any other law enforcement agency within the state. Individuals who leave their child with personnel at these receiving sites will remain anonymous, as long as abuse is not identified, and need not fear arrest or prosecution.
